## Learning Objectives

- a) Explain the origin and purpose of ICAO aviation security related legal instruments, Annex 17 and the Security Manual (ICAO Doc 8973)
- b) Apply basic concepts of management to aviation security and explain the specialist role of the aviation security manager.
- c) Plan, develop and organize the human and material resources necessary for the effective operation of an aviation security unit.
- d) Plan and administer the financial budget for a security unit.
- e) Advise on the development of aviation security programmes and Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's)
- f) Monitor and enforce the implementation of aviation security programmes and SOP's.
- g) Verify that security personnel are able to implement aviation security preventative measures.
- h) Advise on the development of airport emergency plans and manage the security response action necessary in security emergencies involving aircraft, terminal buildings and airport facilities.
