

FAA FAR Essentials for Powerplant Repair Stations – 1 Day

Introduction

There is no doubt that the aviation industry is comprehensively regulated with each regulatory authority having its own regulations peculiar to their country – for the personnel employed in maintenance activities, regulations can be a "minefield" to maneuver through and understand how their role impacts aviation quality and safety and their organisations business.

The U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is one of the major regulatory bodies with aspects of its regulations structure that differ from their European counterpart – the European Aviation Safety Administration (EASA).

This training focuses on essential FAA regulations that personnel employed in a FAA 14 CFR Part 145 certificated Repair Station should have an understanding of, and how those personnel should apply the regulations during their daily tasks.

The instructor covers the applicable regulations and relevant guidance material, provides examples of how the regulations and business intersect, and differences between the FAA and EASA regulations.

The course is also relevant to individuals who are preparing to take FAA certification exams, such as the FAA Power plant Mechanic certification.
