

EASA Part 66 – Essentials – 1 Day

Introduction

EASA Part-66 is a common European aircraft maintenance license recognized in all EASA member states. The regulations define the conditions under which a maintenance engineer is authorized to release an aircraft into service after a maintenance operation.

On the basis of the Maintenance Engineers License, together with satisfactory demonstration of competency and knowledge of organizational procedures the personal authorization document is issued by an approved Part-145 organization.

The conditions required are defined by minimum education requirements (school and college certificates, language competency, etc.) as well as type rating qualifications for the relevant aircraft or particular tasks.

This one-day course provides delegates with an insight into the requirements of the regulation. Whilst the course is aimed specifically at, stakeholders as well those with limited Part 66 knowledge, who never the less require a fundamental understanding of their obligations and responsibilities.

On completion delegates shall understand and be able to explain the basic license structure together with the various categories A, B1, B2, B3 & C, how organizations can ensure that they understand and manage the process in the most effective way.

Who is the Course for?

The course is designed for individuals who are seeking to obtain or renew their Aircraft Maintenance License (AML) or interested in a career in aircraft maintenance. It is also beneficial for professionals who are working in the aviation industry and require an understanding of the regulations and principles of aircraft maintenance.
